Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters!

We are glad to inform you that the Girl Guides Association Malaysia is organising the Girls' Summit 2022: Camp Surf-Vival which is scheduled to be held at Girl Guides Wilderness Park, Sandakan, Sabah, Malaysia from 27th to 30th October, 2022.

Girls' Summit 2022: Camp Surf-Vival will be carried out in the beautiful town of Sandakan; home of the Sepilok Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre and Bornean Sun Bear Conservation Centre. It aims to reinforce young girls' awareness and connection to nature and we will be completing the YUNGA: FORESTS Badge Challenge. Another highlight is the WAGGGS Surf Smart 2.0 program which will be carried out to encourage young girls to be smart and safe on the Internet. This event will also help girls and young women of the Asia Pacific Region to connect and enhance international sisterhood.

Weather	:	Hot and humid with day temperatures of approximately 31 degrees Celcius (Bring a cap/hat). May rain (so please ring your raincoat).
Registration Fee	:	USD 120.00 (INR. 9600/- approx.) per participant (Inclusive of lodging, food and event activities, ground transportation).

Caution Money	: Rs. 10,000/- Non-refundable (if selected and not participated and adjustable after participation). Selected candidates will have to pay Rs. 1000/- as administrative charges, Rs. 2500/- towards Scout/Guide welfare fund and Rs. 1500/- for magazine subscription which will be adjusted from caution money and balance amount is refundable after submission of event report to NHQ. Travel Cost	: Approximately Airfare from New Delhi to Sandakan Airport via Kuala Lumpur or Kota Kinabalu and back, travel cost is Rs. 40,000/- (Approx.) subject to actual on the date of booking.
VISA Cost	: Rs. 5000/- Malaysia (Tourist) VISA lies in the discretion of Malaysia Embassy. The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters is not responsible if VISA is rejected due to any reason/reasons thereof. Hence, no claim is admissible.
Last Date of Application	: Limited seats are available – Selection will be on “first come first basis” . Application of the willing candidate should to be along with UTR No. of fees paid of Rs. 10,000/- to wagggs@bsgindia.org with a copy to girlprogramme@bsgindia.org on or before 15th October, 2022 . Brief details will be provided in the selection letter after receipt of application form and caution money. Event fees to be paid directly to the Girl Guides Association Malaysia on receipt of selection letter.
