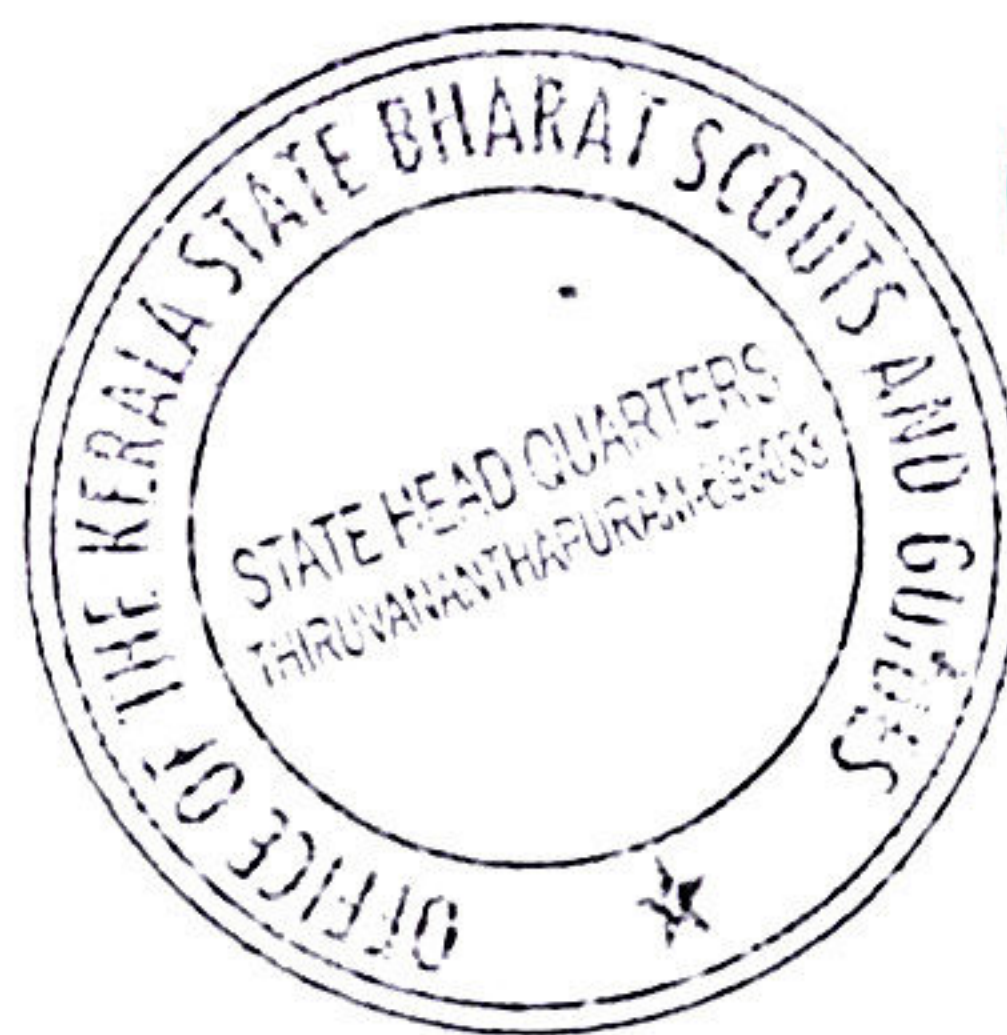

For the booking of seats: Scout Guide Welfare Fund Rs. 500/- as registration fee per head is to be paid in advance which is non - refundable but can be adjusted in other programme within the same financial year (In the case of Covid-19 like situation it will be adjusted in next financial year). The Booking confirmation will be informed after receiving of registration fee. For the direct deposit through Bank, the Bank charges will be borne by the candidates / Institution. The Scout Guide Welfare Fund Rs. 3,000/- per head (this will be cover accommodation, food, souvenir/ gift item and activities). The Applications, Medical & Risk certificate should be produced at the time of Registration. Without Applications, Medical & Risk certificate participants will not be admitted. Total fee will cover all expenses on programme such as Food, Accommodation, Training Equipment, Gift item and other miscellaneous expenses. Accommodation will be in tents only (Ground sheet, mattress will be supplied). **Each Participant will be awarded National Level Participation Certificate on successful completion of the programme.**

Booking will be made on "First Come First Serve Basis". Selection Letter will be sent on receipt of Scout Guide Welfare Fund as registration fee Rs. 500/- per head along with number of participants (male & female). Balance amount Rs. 2500/- per head is payable in cash/through bank transfer at the time of registration at campsite. One Escort must be deputed with a group of 1 to 15 Boys / Girls. Lady escort must be deputed with the female participants. Escorts should also register and pay the full fee along with Application, Medical Certificate. **No one is permitted to stay in the camp without Registration and Medical Certificate. No age limit for escort teacher but he/she should be physically & medically fit. Preference may please given to under 60 years of age.**

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE: It is open to all the members of The Bharat Scouts and Guides, all the Educational Institutions, Adventure clubs and other Youth Organizations who are interested in promoting and participating in adventure activities for the age group 12 to 45 years, who is medically and physically fit and can bear the strain of adventure. Any individual can participate with identity proof.

PROGRAMME: Tentative Programme may be Expedition, Trekking, Artificial Rock Climbing, Rappelling, Rifle, Pistol Shooting, Archery, Obstacles Crossing, Fun-Bases etc. Daily Camp Fire at night is the entertainment of the programme.

Sight Seeing: (1) Delhi - Lotus Temple, Kutub Minar, India Gate, Lal Quila, Akshardham and Rajghat.

(2) Agra - Taj Mahal, Agra Fort etc. **(3) Mathura/ Vrindavan** - Prem Mandir, Iskon, Banke Bihari Temple etc.

HOW TO REACH : National Youth Complex, Gadpuri, Dist. Palwal, Haryana

- Gadpuri is situated on the Mathura road in between Palwal and Ballabgarh (just 10 k.m. from Ballabgarh and 15 k.m. from Palwal), share auto are available from both station.
- From Sarai Kalen Khan Buses are available for Palwal. Get down at Gadpuri bus stand.
- Nearest Railway Station is Palwal/Ballabgarh/Hazrat Nizamudin/New Delhi.
- Nearest Metro Station is Raja Nahar Singh (Ballabgarh) in Violet line. Direct Metro is available from Kashmiri Gate/ Mandi House/ Central Secretariat.

THE PARTICIPANTS WILL BRING FOLLOWING MATERIALS WITH THEM.

1. 01 No. of Stamp size colour photograph (recent one).
2. Water Bottle, Torch, etc.
3. Note book, Pen, First Aid Kit, Cold Cream and Odomas etc.
4. Hunter/ Sport Shoes, Extra Pairs of Socks & Slippers.
5. Plate, Glass, Spoon, Full sleeves T. Shirt, Jeans and Track- Suits extra wearing cloths and costumes for cultural items. One set of correct and complete uniform as per APRO part – II & III. (For Scouts & Guides only). Temperature will be cold. Warm bedding is recommendation with mosquito net.
6. Any other items as per the need of the individual.
7. Each participant has to carry mask, hand-sanitizer and soap for personal use.

SAFETY: The Bharat Scouts and Guides take every care of the participants sincerely, but the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters will not be responsible for any accident, illness or injury during or after the programme. The escorting teachers should take extra precaution/care of their students before the camp, during the camp and after the camp.

PROGRAMME

To meet the urge and need of the young people, National Youth Adventure Institute, Gadpuri is Organising following programmes throught the year in winter and summer seasons:

- One Day Adventure Programme
- Two Day Adventure programme
- Three Day Adventure Programme
- Five Day Adventure Programme



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

It is open to all the members of the Bharat Scouts and Guides, all the educational Institutions, Adventure clubs and other Voluntary Youth Organisation who are interested in promoting and participating in adventure activities.



The Participants should fulfil the following Conditions:

1. Youth age group 08 to 45 years.
2. Participants should be physically fit to undertake strenuous activities during the programme
3. In case of participants less than 18 years, one adult leader for every 06 to 08 members should accompany and he/she should not be more than 45 years of age and should be physically fit.
4. Medically fitness certificates from registered Medical Practitioner should be sent along with the application form by the participants including escorts.

ACTIVITIES

The programme includes Expedition, Trekking, Rock Climbing Artificial, Rappelling, Zip Line, Rifle & Pistol Shooting, Archery Crossing and Encountering obstacles, Fun Base, Water Activities, Camp Fire. In addition, daily morning physical jerks, inspection and information about Scout/Guide movement are the other attraction of the programme.

HOW TO APPLY

Application in prescribed form along with medical fitness certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner and Rs. 300/- towards registration fee in Scout Guide Welfare fund (non-refundable) is to be deposited in Bharat Scouts and Guides National Youth Adventure Institute bank account.

SELECTION

Selection Information will be sent through E-mail/ Post on receipt of Application form, Medical Form and registration fee.





CERTIFICATE

Participants who successfully completes the National Youth Adventure Programme will be Awarded “National Level Participation Certificate”.

WHAT TO BRING

One set of Scout and Guide Uniform (for Scouts/Guides only). back pack/haver sack, bed sheet, full sleeves cotton shirt/T-Shirt, cotton pants/ jeans/track suit, p-cap, sports shoes, 02 pair cotton socks, water bottle, mug and plate, lunch box, pen/pencil, note book, first aid kit, odomos, toilet requisite etc. as instructed in package, woollen jerseys or thick jacket, sleeping bag/blankets. personal medicine etc.

RISK MANAGEMENT AND SAFETY MEASURES

Extensive and painstaking preparation have gone into the planning of the adventure programs for ensuring the safety of the participants. Our field staff and experienced instructors have been visiting the area to check all details. Every care is taken in case of each participant regarding the programme, accommodation, food, sanitation etc. Even then the Institute will not be responsible for any unforeseen events that may occur during the programme.

SANITATION

Apucca toilet block is provided separately to Male and Female participants and Staff.

ACCOMMODATION

Tent Accommodation is provided to the participants on raised cement platform. Daily Anti Mosquito spray is done in the evening.



MEDICAL FACILITY

During the programme Medical facility will be made available round the clock.

FOOD



Nutritious cooked food is served to the participants keeping in view of the food habits of all parts of the country. Only Vegetarian food is served. In addition to this the facility of Fridge, Aqua Guard, Water Cooler too are there.

EQUIPMENT SHOP

Scout/Guide equipment, literature, P-Cap, T-shirt, Metal Badge and Souvenir etc. will be available at National Youth Complex Scout Shop.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTION

1. We protect wild life and nature.
2. This is environmental friendly program. Participants should not litter. In case they find any wrapper or plastic bag containing something left by others on the way, they should carry the same with them to deposit in the campsite. All garbage be deposited in earmarked location only.
3. Booking on any program is confirmed only on receipt of the Scout Guide Welfare Fund with application.
4. Due to heavy rush, book early to avoid disappointment.
5. Registration can be made for any programme in any month but selection will be made on first come first serve basis.
6. Fee includes food, accommodation equipment, First Aid and other training expenses during the programme.
7. A hearty welcome to one and all awaits at the National Youth Adventure Institute, Gadpuri, Palwal, Haryana
